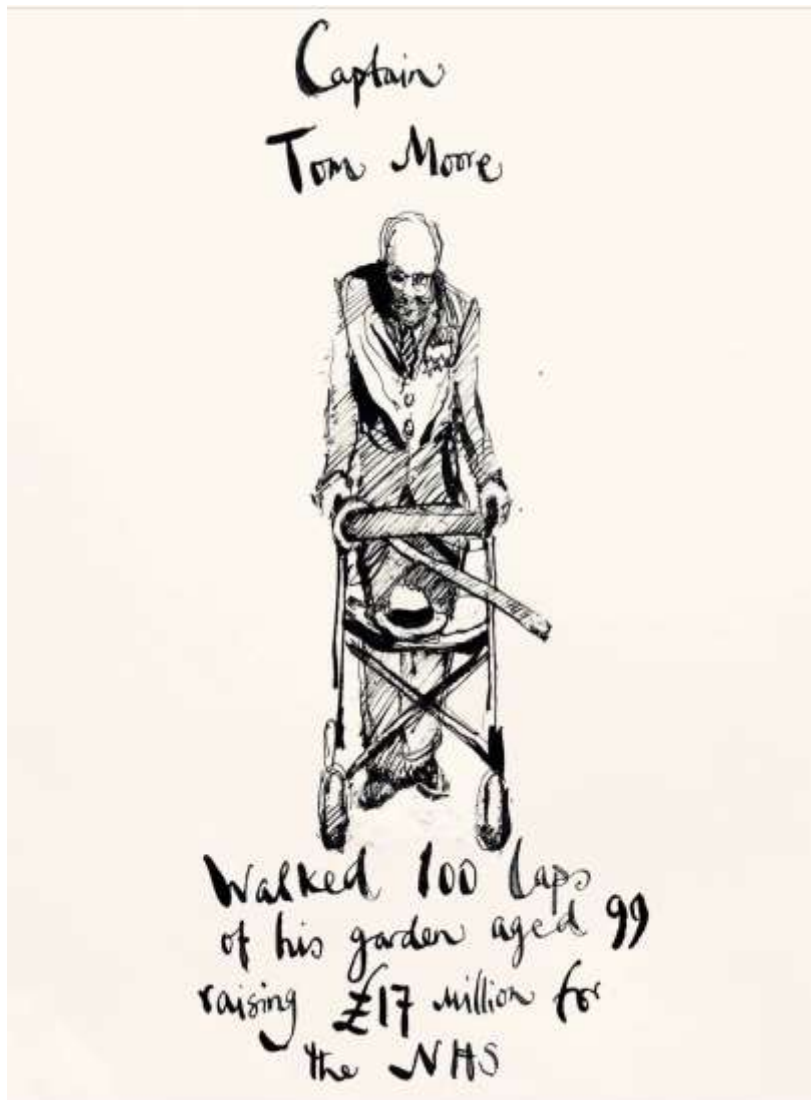


RAINBOW IDEAS – w/c 29nd June
