Southgate Class Curriculum Information Autumn Term 2021

Key Statement: What is a lightbulb moment?

This term's topic based learning 'Inventions' has a history focus with us finding out about different inventors and the wonderful objects they have helped to create. We are considering

key events in history such as the invention of flight and electricity. We are exploring the work

of Marie Curie, Ambroise Paré and Garret Morgan.

Literacy - We are considering the key features of different non-fiction texts such as letters,

instructions and biographies. We are also focusing on the fictional story 'Izzy Gizmo' who doesn't

give up in order to create a new invention. We are writing our own fiction story.

Maths - We are working on numbers up to 100 in numerals and words. We are continuing to

practise our addition and subtraction skills. We are recognising coins and notes.

Science - We are exploring different materials and finding out how some can be changed by

stretching, squashing and bending them.

Physical Development - We are continuing to practise our balls skills, particularly throwing and

catching. We are learning the rules of basketball and finding out about wheelchair basketball.

Religious Education - We are focusing on Islam during the period of Ramadan and finding out

how Muslims celebrate this festival. We are considering stories from the Bible and celebrating

Christmas.

Art/D&T - We are looking at the artwork of Banksy, thinking about the messages they portray and creating our own artwork inspired by him. We are also learning about Leonardo DiVinci and
