## Love Class LOCKDOWN Curriculum Information



### This term's learning is 'What a Wonderful World'.

#### What do I see?

**In these unprecedented times whilst we are away from each other, our main priority is to stay safe, healthy, happy and hopeful. We need to support each other in this wonderful community in which we live.**

Topic based learning for this term has a geography focus. In particular children are focusing on the 4 countries that make up the United Kingdom then travelling further afield to countries all around the world. We are finding out about different traditions within these countries and discovering spectacular landmarks.

**Communication and Language/Literacy** - We are continuing to learn new Makaton signs weekly. We are learning the story 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' and listening to other bear stories. We are innovating and inventing our own stories and looking at non-fiction texts later in the term, including post cards and letters.

**Maths** - We are continuing to practise our adding skills and focusing on subtracting. We are also learning about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

**Science** - We are focusing on the change of seasons from Winter to Spring and describing how day length varies between the two seasons. We are collecting and recording simple data.

**Physical Development** - We are practising dances from around the world including the British Folk Dance and the New Zealand Haka.

**Religious Education** - We are finding out about the Easter story and how Christians celebrate this special time of the year.

**Expressive Arts** - We are focusing on the work of *Henri Matisse* and *Heather Galler* creating artwork using collaging and the use of shape and pattern. We are also being inspired by African geometric textile designs.

**Music** - We are continuing to remember and learn Makaton signs through singing. We are focusing on 'What a Wonderful World' to perform to each other. We are also learning some Cornish songs to help celebrate St. Piran's Day.

**Learning and teaching will focus on keeping hope and getting through this- we can do this! #the show must go on #be strong. Children's emotional well-being is a huge consideration for us over this term.**

Children are expected to read for 20 minutes every day and record this in their reading record.
