Dear Parents,

We are hoping that Marazion School Breakfast Club is up and running again soon and we are already offering more choice for our school lunches (see below). Please note that Marazion Oasis is offering after school care for all the staggered pick ups, including from 1pm; 1.15pm or 1.30pm on Fridays.

Marazion School's Year of Recovery.

Drop Off - Siblings

From NEXT Monday 14th September, all siblings can be dropped off at the same time. Siblings who start later are able to go to their classroom until their school day starts. Adults from their class bubble will be in class at this time.

Marazion School Breakfast Club (BC)

We are hoping to start BC from Monday 21st September. BC will be in the canteen and children will have breakfast in their class bubble groups. As this space is much smaller, we are asking parents to only use BC if it is a necessity. We can offer 12 places each morning from 8am. There is now a booking system for BC so please ring the school office and let Laura Fox know if you want to book a place for your child. The cost is £1 per pupil. Please note that there is no cost for Pupil Premium pupils.

Marazion School Lunches

From NEXT Monday 14th September we can offer jacket potatoes as part of our school lunch menu with a choice of fillings - cheese; beans; tuna mayo. We are also able to offer fish fingers or chicken nuggets and chips on Fridays, starting from NEXT Friday 18th September.

Marazion After School Bubble Clubs

Although we are currently unable to offer a range of after school clubs, from week commencing Monday 21st September each class will have their own After School Bubble Club. An After School Bubble Club letter will be sent out next week. These clubs are optional and will mainly focus on adults and children (from the same bubble) working on outdoor projects:

Mondays: Love, Year 1 children ONLY (2.45-3.30pm); Empowerment, Year 6 (3.15-4pm)

Tuesdays: Hope, Year 2 (3-3.45pm); Faith (3.15-4pm)

Wednesdays: Courage, Year 4/5 (2.45-3.30pm)

Adventure Days

For this year we have planned local Adventure Days, including on the school site. These days are slightly longer (but not the usual extended day) and do not include overnight camps. **Faith (Year 3/4) Adventure Day is NEXT Wednesday 16th September:** pupils in Faith are heading down to Red River to launch their topic 'Just a Drop in the Ocean'. They are looking at water from source to sea and spending the day building dams, lakes and more. Please can pupils wear their own clothes - warm layers with a waterproof coat if the weather is wet and cold / lighter clothing if the weather is hot as well as a hat. Pupils also need sunscreen for hot weather. Please can pupils wear shoes that are comfortable for walking and for the beach. Pupils need a packed lunch from home unless your child is pupil premium (PP) - school will provide a packed lunch for PP pupils. Please note that there is a later pick up from school at **4.00pm** at the normal pick up point, which is the gate to the school playground.
