## Marazion School Start/ Finish Time

From Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June we are having the same start/finish time for all classes but there are some 'COVID Keeps' (CKs) as well. The Marazion School day will now start @ 8.45am and finish @ 3pm. The playground, classrooms and a NEW Reading Room (RR) will be open from 8.30am. Children can choose to stay on the playground, go to their classrooms or go to the RR. Children can be dropped off from 8.30am but must be in school for 8.45am. CKs: children/parents usually arriving at the playground gate can line up on the rainbows on the pavement and only children will go into the playground. Children are collected from the playground gate at the end of the day - again with parents using the rainbows; **Courage** and **Empowerment** continue to use the school drive/the playing field to arrive and leave; there is no parking on School Lane with everyone walking (or biking or scootering!) the last part of their journey to school. Please note that Breakfast Club is 7.45am to 8.45am from 14<sup>th</sup> June.

**Suncream and hats:** Please note that during the summer term it is important that you send your child into school with a named bottle of sun cream and a suitable hat to screen them from the sun. This is important for children in all classes. Thanks. **School Visits: Faith** are off to Geevor Mine on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> May. Children are to wear their own clothes and also bring a waterproof coat/ sun hat and sun cream as the weather is rather changeable at the moment. Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch and a refillable water bottle as well. Children are back before the end of the normal school day. **Courage** are going to Helston Museum followed by a visit to the Victorian Village and Britain in the Blitz on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> May. Children need to be in school for an early start @ 8:15am and are back in school for a later pick up @ 4pm.
