Dear Parents,

There are more relaxations of COVID-19 restrictions from next Monday 17th May and it seems that, at the moment, the country's roadmap out of the pandemic is going to plan so far. We are working on 'reimagination' plans that will create our own Marazion roadmap as things become more usual. We are taking a cautious approach and taking our time instead of doing everything at once. We had our Celebration Assembly outside as a whole school today - on the playing field. It was fantastic to all be in the same place together! We hope that, soon after 21st June, we can have the same start/finish times to the school day for all classes as well as going back to children being in school for a full day on Fridays. Marazion Community Centre Car Park

Please can parents make sure that they are displaying their valid car park passes for Marazion Community Centre in a clear and visible place. If you are using this car park without a pass, please call the School Office and we can arrange for one to be sent home with your child. Thanks.

Headlice - Treatment and Prevention

Please can you check your child's hair for headlice at least once a week. Thanks. This is important in order to make sure that the source of infection is always managed. Local expert advice supports treatment with the Wet Combing Method - at least a weekly check of wet hair at hair wash time to detect headlice using a good quality detection comb and conditioner. If live lice are detected this method should be used every 3 days for 2-3 weeks in order to prevent re-infection. Headlice can affect anyone in the community and if you find someone in your family has headlice, it is important to inform all close contacts.
