Spring 2 Themes

For spring term our Share Your Views (SYV) board focuses on our memories from Lockdown and now includes Lockdown 3. Our Vision and Aims Board (in the learning area outside Courage's classroom) focuses on our second aim: Our school aims to support and celebrate the whole child to reveal: Positive relationships showing love, tolerance and respect - thinking about how this second aim is reflected in our daily school life.
