We are having some school building work carried out over the summer and hope to come back to a school with a new roof. Midas Construction have been appointed as main contractors for the scheme. We have also been working super hard on developing our Marazion outdoor spaces so that they are ready for our return. We now have a roundhouse; a fairy house; a larger fire pit; the start of an orchard as well as a polytunnel, which we want to develop into a flower farm...and that's just the first phase! So, our September Adventure Days (ADs) are still planned and will be based on the school site - more details in September. Please note that ADs do not include overnight camps this year.

Marazion Playing Field Playground

A reminder that Marazion Town Council are working in partnership with Marazion Playing Field Association to renew the play area in the playing fields. This will involve removing the sand ground covering and replacing it with a multicoloured rubber surface. The old swings are going to be replaced with a new set; the climbing tower will be removed and replaced by a new nature tower play frame and the see-saw will be replaced by a Trenance trawler play boat. This exciting project will start next month and will hopefully be able to be used on completion, if health restrictions allow. This is wonderful news!
