

Dear Parents.

Welcome back to the summer term We are hoping for lots of sunny days and getting out and about more, as long as it is safe to do so. Please see information below about current COVID-19 restrictions. A reminder that children need to wear usual school uniform to school, including black shoes, except on PE Days when children should come to school in PE kit. PE kit is grey/black joggers, leggings or shorts and a white t-shirt. PE Days are as follows: Love - Monday and Thursday; Hope -Monday and Thursday; Faith - Monday and Wednesday; Courage - Monday and Friday; Empowerment - Tuesday and Wednesday.
