## Spring Super Learning Day (SLD)

Next Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January is our spring SLD. The theme is World Religions and children are working in their Beach Groups, taking part in 6 different workshops looking at different religions through the medium of art. They are creating stained glass windows; making a clay Buddha; painting the Golden Temple; creating Rangoli patterns with rice; investigating geometrical patterns with sticks and ink and working with paper to make Royzelekhs. Children need to come into school wearing school uniform as usual.
